ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- 2. Pass the Malaysian Skills Certificate (SKM) Level 3 in a related field and pass SPM with a minimum of 1 credit including Mathematics and passed English; OR
- 3. Pass the Malaysian Higher School Certificate (STPM) with a minimum grade of C (GPA2.00) in any subject; OR
- 4. Pass the Malaysian Higher Certificate of Religion (STAM) with a minimum grade of Magbul (Pass); OR
- 5. Any qualification equivalent to a certificate (Level 3, Malaysian Qualification Framework).
