- Passed Sijil Tinggi Agama Malaysia (STAM) with a minimum grade of Maqbul (Pass) and passed in Mathematics and Biology/Physics/Chemistry/Applied Science SPM; OR
- Any qualification equivalent to a certificate (Level 3, Malaysian Qualification Framework).
